



Choose a costume that is made of flame retardant material

Costumes should be well fitting as well as shoes to avoid trips

Use non-toxic makeup vs a mask when possible

If using a mask make sure it is well fitting and provides adequate vision and ventilation

Add reflective tape to the costume or trick or treat bag

Younger children should walk with an adult

Older children should walk in groups.

Only trick or treat in well lit familiar neighborhoods

Do not go to the door of any unlit houses

Never ever under any circumstance enter a house, even just into the doorway to grab candy from the bowl. DO NOT ENTER

Pay attention while walking, a car could pull out of a driveway

Only cross at cross walks

All costume accessories should be soft and flexible

DO NOT eat any candy until inspected by an adult

Never eat anything that was not commercially wrapped, No homemade treats

Adults: Keep candles and jack-o-lanterns away from doorsteps, landings and porches...costumes may be flowing

Adults: Pay extra attention driving
